#### 3 Structure of the RFP

- I. This Request for Proposal (RFP) document for Appointment of the System Integrator for e-District Mission Mode Project (MMP) for MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Government of Manipur comprise of the following.
- II. MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Government of Manipur invites bids from eligible parties (hereafter referred as "Bidder") for appointment as System Integrator for the State of Manipur and provide the comprehensive solution as specified in the Scope of Work Section (Refer Section 4 in Volume II) of this RFP.

- A. Volume I: Instructions on the Bid process for the purpose of responding to this RFP. This broadly covers:
  - 1. General instructions for bidding process.
  - 2. Bid evaluation process including the parameters for Technical evaluation and commercial evaluation to facilitate MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Government of Manipur in determining bidder's suitability as the implementation partner.
  - 3. Payment schedule.
  - 4. Commercial bid and other formats.
- B. Volume II: Functional and Technical Requirements of the project. The contents of the document broadly cover the following areas:
  - 1. About the project and its objectives.
  - 2. Scope of work for the Implementation Partner.
  - 3. Functional and Technical requirements.
  - 4. Project Schedule.
  - 5. Service levels for the implementation partner.

The bidder is expected to respond to the requirements as completely and in as much relevant detail as possible, and focus on demonstrating bidder's suitability to become the implementation partner of MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur.

C. Volume III: Master Service Agreement (MSA), Service Level Agreement (SLA) and Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA).(provided separately in Annexure I)

The bidders are expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, Project requirements and other information in the RFP documents. Failure to furnish all information required as mentioned in the RFP documents or submission of a proposal not substantially responsive to the RFP documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the proposal.

#### 4 Background Information

#### 4.1 Basic Information

- I. MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur invites proposals ("e-Tenders") to this Request for Proposals ("RFP") from Systems Integrator Agencies ("Bidders") for the provision of IMPLEMENTATION OF e-DISTRICT MMP.
- II. Any contract that may result from this Government procurement competition will be issued for a term of 3 years ("the Term").

- III. The MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur reserves the right to extend the Term for a period or periods of up to 6 months to a maximum of 12 months such extension or extensions on the same terms and conditions, subject to the MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur's obligations at law.
- IV. Proposals must be received not later than time, date mentioned in the Fact Sheet. Proposals that are received late WILL NOT be considered in this procurement process.

# 4.2 Project Background

I. NeGP was approved by the Government of India in May 2006, with the following vision:

"Make all Government Services accessible to the common man in his locality, through common service delivery outlets and ensure efficiency, transparency and reliability of such services at affordable costs to realise the basic needs of the common man".

- II. To realize this vision, 31 Central, State and Integrated Mission Mode projects (MMPs) along with 8 support components were identified and approved under NeGP. States have been given flexibility to identify up to 5 additional state-specific projects, which are particularly relevant for the economic development of the State. NeGP also envisages creation of the core IT infrastructure in the form of SWANs, SDCs and one lakh front ends namely CSCs in rural areas across the country to deliver public services electronically.
- III. e-District is one of the 31 MMPs under NeGP, with the Department of Electronics and Information Technology (DeitY), Government of India (GoI) as the nodal department, to be implemented by State Government or their designated agencies. This MMP aims at electronic delivery of identified high volume citizen centric services, at district and sub-district level, those are not part of any other MMP. To achieve these objectives service levels and outcomes for each of these services will be clearly laid down by the State concerned, with a view to improving the efficiency and effectiveness of the service delivery. The MMP envisages leveraging and utilizing the four pillars of e-infrastructure namely, State Data Centres (SDCs), State Wide Area Network (SWANs), State Service Delivery Gateways (SSDGs) and Common Service Centres (CSCs), optimally to deliver public services electronically to citizens at their door steps. Initially only those high volume citizen-centric services will be taken up for implementation which have high priority for the State. New services will be added to the portfolio subsequently, once the demand for the initial set of e-enabled services increases.

IV. Detailed scope of work is provided in volume II.

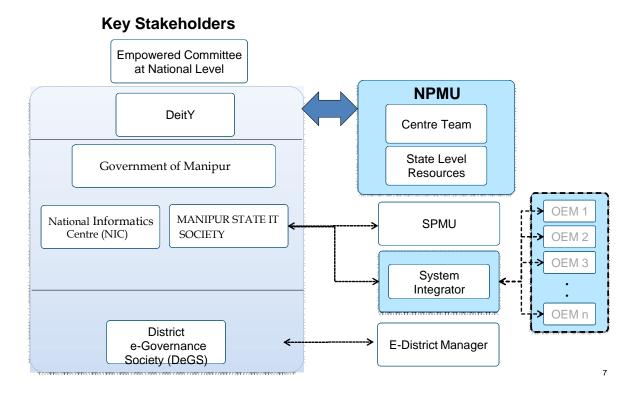
# 4.4 Key Information

The objectives of the e-District Mission Mode Project are to ensure the following:

- I. Providing easy, anywhere and anytime access to government services (both information & transactional) to ensure reliability, efficiency, transparency and accountability.
- II. Delivery of all public services at district/ sub district level in electronic form through state portals by using the SSDG.
- III. Reducing number of visits of citizens to a government office / department for availing the services and thereby eliminating harassment.
- IV. Reducing administrative burden and service fulfilment time and costs for the government, citizens & businesses.
- V. Reducing direct interaction of citizen with the government and encourage 'e'-interaction and efficient communication through portal.
- VI. Enhancing perception & image of the Government and its constituent Departments.
- VII. Undertake backend computerisation of District and Block level offices to ensure electronic delivery of high volume citizen centric services at the district level.

- VIII. Efficient delivery of services with improved service levels by undertaking extensive Business Process Re-engineering (BPR) of identified services.
  - IX. Delivery of services through CSCs by leveraging the common infrastructure of SWAN, SDC, and SSDG.
  - X. Development of applications to be hosted at the SDCs for delivery of services.
  - XI. Extensive capacity building and training of field level functionaries to ensure smooth migration to electronic delivery of e-district services and phasing out manual delivery of services.

# 4.5 About the Department/SDA

Manipur State Information Technology Society (MSITS) was established in June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2008 under Section 7(1) of the Manipur Societies Registration Act 1989 (Manipur Act I of 1990). It is under the administrative control of Department of Information Technology (DIT), Government of Manipur and is the State Designated Agency/Implementing Agency for all National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) projects in the State of Manipur.

The National e-Governance Plan (NeGP), approved by the Government of India, is a major countrywide initiative aimed at spreading the benefits of e-Governance to all citizens. Under

the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP), Government of Manipur strategically decided to take effective steps for the development of information system and utilization of information resources and decided to introduce computer based decision support system in various Government Departments. This in turn will facilitate planning and program implementation for effective governance and better delivery of services to citizens.

MSITS envisages to take up activities promoting investments and growth in Information Technology Industry and encourage private sector initiative in Information Technology related infrastructure and services so as to increase the contribution of Information Technology in the economic growth and social development of the State.

MSITS has undertaken the various schemes as a part of National e-Governance Plan implementation in Manipur:

- I. State Data Centre (SDC)
- II. State Wide Area Network (SWAN)
- III. Common Service Centres (CSC)
- IV. State Portal, State Service Delivery Gateway and e-forms (SP, SSDG & e-forms)
- V. Capacity Building (CB)
- VI. e-District

MSITS has been taking up the schemes for providing adequate infrastructure in the State that the Information Technology sector can flourish in state of Manipur.

#### 5 Instructions to the Bidders

#### 5.1 General

- I. While every effort has been made to provide comprehensive and accurate background information and requirements and specifications, Bidders must form their own conclusions about the solution needed to meet the requirements. Bidders and recipients of this RFP may wish to consult their own legal advisers in relation to this RFP. All information supplied by Bidders may be treated as contractually binding on the Bidders, on successful award of the assignment by the MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur on the basis of this RFP.
- II. No commitment of any kind, contractual or otherwise shall exist unless and until a formal written contract has been executed by or on behalf of the MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur. Any notification of preferred bidder status by the MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur shall not give rise to any enforceable rights by the Bidder. The MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur may cancel this public procurement at any time prior to a formal written contract being executed by or on behalf of the MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur.
- III. This RFP supersedes and replaces any previous public documentation & communications, and Bidders should place no reliance on such communications.

# 5.2 Compliant Proposals / Completeness of Response

- I. Bidders are advised to study all instructions, forms, terms, requirements and other information in the RFP documents carefully. Submission of the bid shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the RFP document with full understanding of its implications.
- II. Failure to comply with the requirements of this paragraph may render the Proposal non-compliant and the Proposal may be rejected. Bidders must:
  - A. Include all documentation specified in this RFP.
  - B. Follow the format of this RFP and respond to each element in the order as set out in this RFP.
  - C. Comply with all requirements as set out within this RFP.

### 5.2.1 Issue of Corrigendum

I. At any time prior to the last date for receipt of bids, MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur may, for any reason can modify the RFP Document by a corrigendum.

- II. The Corrigendum (if any) will be posted on the <a href="www.msits.gov.in">www.msits.gov.in</a>, <a href="www.msits.gov.in">www.msits.gov.in</a>, and <a href="https://manipurtenders.gov.in">https://manipurtenders.gov.in</a>
- III. Any such corrigendum shall be deemed to be incorporated into this RFP.
- IV. In order to provide prospective Bidders reasonable time for taking the corrigendum into account, MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur may, at its discretion, extend the last date for the receipt of Proposals.

# 5.3 Key Requirements of the Bid

# 5.3.1 Right to Terminate the Process

- I. MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur may terminate the RFP process at any time and without assigning any reason. MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur makes no commitments, express or implied, that this process will result in a business transaction with anyone.
- II. This RFP does not constitute an offer by MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur. The bidder's participation in this process may result MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur selecting the bidder to engage towards execution of the contract.

# 5.3.2 Submission of Proposals

- a) The bidders should submit their responses through <a href="https://manipurtenders.gov.in">https://manipurtenders.gov.in</a> as per the format given in this RFP.
- b) Please Note that prices should not be indicated in the Technical Proposal but should only be indicated in the Commercial Proposal.
- c) All the pages of the uploaded proposal must be sequentially numbered and must contain the list of contents with page numbers. Any deficiency in the documentation may result in the rejection of the Bid.
- d) All pages of the bid including the duplicate copies, shall be initialled and stamped by the person or persons who is authorised to sign the bid.
- e) In case of any discrepancy observed by MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur in the contents of the submitted original paper bid documents with respective copies, the information furnished on original paper bid document will prevail over others.

### 5.4 Preparation and Submission of Proposal

# 5.4.1 Proposal Preparation Costs

a) The bidder shall be responsible for all costs incurred in connection with participation in the RFP process, including, but not limited to, costs incurred in conduct of informative and other diligence activities, participation in meetings/discussions/presentations, preparation of proposal, in providing any additional information required by MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur to facilitate the evaluation process, and in negotiating a definitive contract or all such activities related to the bid process.

b) MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

# 5.4.2 Language

a) The Proposal should be filled by the Bidder in English language only. If any supporting documents submitted are in any language other than English, translation of the same in English language is to be duly attested by the Bidders. For purposes of interpretation of the Proposal, the English translation shall govern.

# 5.4.3 Venue & Deadline for Submission of Proposals

a) Proposals, in its complete form in all respects as specified in the RFP, must be submitted to MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur through <a href="https://manipurtenders.gov.in">https://manipurtenders.gov.in</a> in Section 2 above.

#### 5.4.4 Late Bids

- a) Bids received after the due date and the specified time (including the extended period if any) for any reason whatsoever, shall not be entertained and shall be returned unopened.
- b) The bids submitted by post/hand/telex/telegram/fax/e-mail etc. shall not be considered. No correspondence will be entertained on this matter.
- c) MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur reserves the right to modify and amend any of the above-stipulated condition/criterion depending upon project priorities vis-à-vis urgent commitments.

### 5.5 Evaluation Process

- a) MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur will constitute a Proposal Evaluation Committee to evaluate the responses of the bidders.
- b) The Proposal Evaluation Committee constituted by the MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur shall evaluate the responses to the RFP and all supporting documents / documentary evidence. Inability to submit requisite supporting documents / documentary evidence, may lead to rejection.

- c) The decision of the Proposal Evaluation Committee in the evaluation of responses to the RFP shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained outside the process of negotiation/ discussion with the Committee.
- d) The Proposal Evaluation Committee may ask for meetings with the Bidders to seek clarifications on their proposals.
- e) The Proposal Evaluation Committee reserves the right to reject any or all proposals on the basis of any deviations.
- f) Each of the responses shall be evaluated as per the criterions and requirements specified in this RFP.

# 5.5.1 Tender Opening

- I. The Commercial Proposals submitted up to 4.00 PM on 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2013 will be opened at 5.00 PM on 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2013by Shri Nambam Deben, Member Secretary, MSITS or any other officer authorized by MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur, in the presence of such of those Bidders or their representatives who may be present at the time of opening.
- II. The representatives of the bidders should be advised to carry the identity card or a letter of authority from the tendering firms to identify their bonafides for attending the opening of the proposal.

# 5.5.2 Tender Validity

The offer submitted by the Bidders should be valid for minimum period of 365 days from the date of submission of Tender.

#### 5.5.3 Tender Evaluation

- I. Initial Bid scrutiny will be held and incomplete details as given below will be treated as non-responsive, if Proposals :
  - A. Are not submitted through <a href="https://manipurtenders.gov.in">https://manipurtenders.gov.in</a> specified in the RFP document.
  - B. Received without the Letter of Authorization (Power of Attorney).
  - C. Are found with suppression of details.
  - D. With incomplete information, subjective, conditional offers and partial offers submitted.
  - E. Submitted without the documents requested in the checklist.
  - F. Have non-compliance of any of the clauses stipulated in the RFP.
  - G. With lesser validity period.

- II. All responsive Bids will be considered for further processing as below:
  - A. MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur will prepare a list of responsive bidders, who comply with all the Terms and Conditions of the Tender. All eligible bids will be considered for further evaluation by a Committee according to the Evaluation process defined in this RFP document. The decision of the Committee will be final in this regard.

#### 6 Criteria for Evaluation

- I. The overall objective of this evaluation process is to select the capable and qualified firm in the business domain of developing and rolling outa Portal, e-District Application, related hardware and other infrastructure, providing associated capacity building, training and handholding support as well as associated managed services and who will provide a comprehensive solution towards Supply, Installation, Integration, Commissioning, Development, Deployment, Operation & Management of e-District Application and hardware provisioning in the state of Manipur.
- II. First the Pre-Qualification Proposal will be evaluated and only those bidders who qualify the requirements will be eligible for next set of evaluations. Technical Proposal and Commercial Proposal of Bidders who do not meet the Pre-Qualification criteria will be returned without opening.
- III. The technical score of all the bidders would be calculated as per the criteria mentioned below. All the bidders who achieve at least 70 marks in the technical evaluation will only be eligible for the evaluation on the Financial/Commercial Component.

## 6.3 Commercial Bid Evaluation

- I. The Financial Bids of technically qualified bidders (i.e. above 70 marks) will be opened on the prescribed date in the presence of bidder representatives.
- II. The bidders should quote for the whole set of services (25 services + 10 Services) indicating total price for all the deliverables and services specified in Annexure II Form2. Bidder shall also provide cost break-up as per Annexure II Form 2.a format.
- III. For any additional Services apart from the identified (35) services shall be priced as per the unit rate quoted.

- IV. The bid price will include all taxes and levies and shall be in Indian Rupees and mentioned separately.
- V. Any conditional bid would be rejected.
- VI. Errors & Rectification: Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis: "If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail".
- VII. If there is no price quoted for certain material or service, the bid shall be declared as disqualified.
- VIII. In the event that there are 2 or more bidders having the same value in the financial bid, the bidder securing the highest technical score will be adjudicated as the "Best responsive bid" for award of the Project.

# 7 Appointment of System Integrator

### 7.1 Award Criteria

MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur will award the Contract to the successful bidder whose financial proposal is the lowest and would consider it as substantially responsive as per the process outlined above.

# 7.2 Right to Accept Any Proposal and To Reject Any or All Proposal(s)

MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur reserves the right to accept or reject any proposal, and to annul the tendering process / Public procurement process and reject all proposals at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the grounds for MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur action.

#### 7.3 Notification of Award

I. Prior to the expiration of the validity period, MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur will notify the successful bidder in writing or by fax or email, that its proposal has been accepted. In case the tendering process / public procurement process has not been completed within the stipulated period, MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur, may like to request the bidders to extend the validity period of the bid.

II. The notification of award will constitute the formation of the contract. Upon the successful bidder's furnishing of Performance Bank Guarantee, MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur will notify each unsuccessful bidder and return their EMD.

#### 7.4 Contract Finalization and Award

- I. The MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur shall reserve the right to negotiate with the bidder(s) whose proposal has been most responsive. On this basis the draft contract agreement would be finalized for award & signing.
- II. MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY may also like to reduce or increase the quantity of any item in the Scope of Work defined in the RFP. Accordingly total contract value may change on the basis of the rates defined in the financial proposal.

#### 7.5 Performance Guarantee

I. The MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur will require the selected bidder to provide a Performance Bank Guarantee, within 15 days from the Notification of award, for a value equivalent to 10% of the total cost of ownership. The Performance Guarantee should be valid for a period of 2 years or total duration of engagement of the Selected Bidder, whichever is later. The Performance Guarantee shall be kept valid till completion of the project and Warranty period. The Performance Guarantee shall contain a claim period of three months from the last date of validity. The selected bidder shall be responsible for extending the validity date and claim period of the Performance Guarantee as and when it is due on account of non-completion of the project and Warranty period. In case the selected bidder fails to submit performance guarantee within the time stipulated, MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur at its discretion may cancel the order placed on the selected bidder without giving any notice. MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur shall invoke the performance guarantee in case the selected Vendor fails to discharge their contractual obligations during the period or MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur incurs any loss due to Vendor's negligence in carrying out the project implementation as per the agreed terms & conditions.

# 7.6 Signing of Contract

I. After the MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur notifies the successful bidder that its proposal has been accepted, MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur shall enter into a contract, incorporating all clauses and the proposal of the bidder between MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur and the successful bidder. The Draft Legal Agreement is provided as a separate document as a template.

# 7.7 Failure to Agree with the Terms and Conditions of the RFP

- I. Failure of the successful bidder to agree with the Draft Legal Agreement and Terms & Conditions of the RFP shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award, in which event MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur may award the contract to the next best value bidder or call for new proposals from the interested bidders.
- II. In such a case, MANIPUR STATE IT SOCIETY, Manipur shall invoke the PBG of the most responsive bidder.
