DST SCIENCE EXCURSION, 2015-16 TO GUWAHATI

1. INTRODUCTION:

The Department of Science & Technology, Manipur, has been organising Science Excursion for school students since last many years to Kolkata, Guwahati and once to IISc Bangalore also. The programme exposes the young school students of this remote State to the advanced Scientific Institutions, Science Centres, Planetariums, Zoological Gardens and various other aspects of the more developed cities of India. For most of the participating students, the DST Science Excursion is their first ever opportunity to travel outside Manipur, and therefore, is a really great experience for them. The DST Science Excursion, 2015-16 will include 65(sixty five) school students and 5(five) Guide Teachers/Officials.

2. OBJECTIVES:

To expose the selected school students of Manipur to the advancements in Science in other cities of India, with a view to build scientific temper and to enthuse them to take up higher studies in Science & Technology subjects.

3. DISTRICT-WISE ALLOCATION OF SEATS:

With a view to ensure participation from all corners of the State, the selection of students will be made as per the following District-wise allocation:

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

All the students of Class IX (nine) studying in any Govt. recognized School under BSEM and CBSE, located in Manipur State as on the date of submission of application are eligible for the DST Science Excursion, 2015-16 to Guwahati.

- Students are required to wear their School uniform during the visit to various places in Guwahati.
- Students are not required to carry bedding, pillow, mosquito net etc. but should carry their own personal clothes, towels and toiletry. The Shilpgram, Guwahati, provides reasonably comfortable accommodation with Canteen facilities.
- Students will fill in a Feedback report on the last day of stay at Guwahati and submit the same to the DST Official Guides. It is also expected that the student will give an account of his/her experience after returning to School, for the benefit of the other students.
- Students will be required to conduct themselves properly as representatives of their respective Schools and of Manipur State. They will follow the instructions of the DST Officials / Guides for smooth conduct of the Excursion and safe return. Any misbehavior and lack of discipline will be reported to the School and participation from that School in DST Science Excursion will be barred for next 2(two) years.

The programme for visit to various Scientific Institutions and places out of the above will be finalized considering the situation of opening and closing of the institutions/places and convenience of schedule/time of the Science Excursion Team.

5. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION:

- a) Applications may be submitted in the prescribed format only.
- b) Up to maximum of 2(two) students may apply from a particular school.
- c) Applicant will have to submit the student contribution of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand) only, within the last date notified, otherwise the seat will be given to the Waiting list students.

6. METHODOLOGY OF SELECTION:

- a) The selection will be on merit as calculated on the basis of Score marks of Class-8 (Eight) examination, subject to the number of seats allocated for the respective District. The Score mark will be the **percentage** of the total marks obtained in Class-8 examination in 6(six) subjects of Science, Mathematics, English, Social Science, Hindi and MIL calculated up to 2(two) rounded decimal points.
- b) After the last date of receipt of applications, 2(two) separate list will be prepared. The First list will have the name of school, name of first student (having the higher score of the two applications) and Score marks in District-wise grouping. The Second list will have the name of school, name of the second student (having the lesser score of the two applications) and Score marks in District-wise grouping.
- c) **First round selection:** Students will be considered for selection District-wise on the basis of their score marks until the District-wise allocation is fully filled up.
- d) **Second round selection:** In case of any seats lying vacant after the First round selection, the seats will be filled up by students from the Second list of that District, on the basis of their score marks.
- e) **Third round selection:** In case of any seats still lying vacant after the Second round selection, all the vacant seats will be pooled and opened to all the remaining applications, for selection on the basis of their score marks.
- f) In addition to filling up the allocated seats, a Waiting list of 10(ten) students will be prepared based on merit from the students who could not be accommodated after the Third round selection.
- g) In case of tie in the Score marks (i.e. same score marks by 2 or more students) the selection will be made by considering the higher marks in the subject of Science. In case of further ties, the higher marks in the subject of Mathematics, Social Science, English, Hindi and MIL will be considered separately in sequence.

7. MODE OF JOURNEY DURATION OF THE SCIENCE EXCURSION:

The DST Science Excursion duration including journey from Imphal to Guwahati and back will be 5(five) days by reserved bus, of which 3(three) days halt at Guwahati with dormitory type of accommodation. The DST Science Excursion will start and end at the DST Office at Old Lambulane, Imphal.

8. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SELECTED STUDENT:

- The selected students will contribute a sum of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One thousand) only each. The remaining cost of journey, accommodation and meal charges, entry fees to various places of visit , miscellaneous expenditure etc.will be borne by this Department.
