- 3. Further, all Administrative Secretaries are advised to instruct the designated officers to extend full co-operation to the Enquiry Officers of the State Vigilance Commission as and when required by the Commission.

The Governor of Manipur is pleased to accept the recommendation and it has been decided that each department may nominate an officer not below the rank of Deputy Secretary against whom no disciplinary case of Vigilance case is pending to be designated as Ex-office Vigilance Officer for their respective departments. Their responsibility and functions will be as follows:-

- (i) To ensure that every employees in their respective Department maintains utmost honesty and integrity and to identify corrupt elements in the department.
- (ii) To keep a watch on activities of the employees suspected to be indulging in corruption, malpractice or misconduct.
- (iii) To initiate prompt action and pursue all cases where reasonable grounds or suspicious of corruption, malpractice or misconduct exist against any employee.

They are further required to furnish a copy of all cases being referred to the Vigilance Commission to the Chief Secretary, Government of Manipur.
