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ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR: MANIPUR

Imphal, the 22nd October, 2018

No.1/4/2018-V(B): In supersession of all previous orders in this regard, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to appoint all the Deputy Commissioners of the Sixteen (16) Districts, Manipur as Ex-Officio Vigilance Officers over and above their normal duties in this their respective districts with immediate effect.

2. The responsibility and functions of the Ex-officio Vigilance Officers will be as follows:-

- i) To ensure that every employee of Government officers located in their respective districts maintain utmost integrity and to identify corrupt elements in the departments.
- ii) To keep a watch on the activities of the employees suspected to be indulging in corruption, malpractices or misconduct and to report to the State Vigilance Commission.
- iii) To initiate prompt action and pursue all cases where reasonable grounds or suspicion of corruption, malpractices or misconduct exists against any employees.

3. It is further ordered that monthly progress report of all cases taken up and pending must be submitted regularly to the (a) Chief Secretary, Government of Manipur and (b) Chief Vigilance Commissioner, Manipur.
