(2) Any period of ad-hoc appointment prior to regularisation of the appointment in consultation with Commission shall not be counted towards the minimum period of service prescribed for promotion.	S.I. (Tax) in the motor Vehicles Department with 4 (four) years regular service in the Grade. Notes: - (1) The promotes should fulfil the condition of qualifying service for promotion on the date on which the proposal is sent to the Commission provided that where a person is considered for such appointment all persons who possess requisite qualification and who are senior to him in the grade shall also be considered irrespective of the fact whether or not they fulfil the requirement as to the minimum period of qualifying service for purpose of promotion mentioned above. (2) Any period of ad-hoc appointment prior to regularisation of the appointment in consultation with Commission shall not be counted towards the minimum period of service prescribed for promotion.	The SI (Enforcement) with 4 (four) years of regular service is eligible for promotion to the post of Inspector (Enforcement) whereas in case of SI (Taxes), it is 5 years of regular service of SI (Taxes) for promotion to Inspector (Taxes). The copies of RRs of the Inspector (Enforcement) and Inspector (Taxes) are enclosed for reference. The SI (Enforcement) and SI (Taxes) are of equivalent posts with same pay scale in Transport Department where the first one deals with enforcement of the MV Act/Rules while the later deals with the collection of taxes. After promotion to Inspectors, both the services will have the avenue for promotion to District Transport Officers (DTOs) in future. Requirement of an additional one year for promotion in case of SI (Taxes) to Inspector (Taxes) in comparison with that of SI (Enf) to Inspector (Enf) will discourage and make disadvantage to the officers of Tax Section in their future line of promotion. Hence the proposal for amendment of the period of regular service of SI (Taxes) to 4 years for promotion to Inspector (Taxes).
