No. 1/57/2015-Plg(Pt-1) : In slight modification of this Department Notification dated 27<sup>th</sup> December 2019 and No.1/57/2015-Plg(Pt) dt 27/12/2019 issued by Planning Department for direct recruitment of three posts of **Research Assistant** and seven post of **Research Investigator (Grade -III level)**, the following are the revised scheme/ changes made for recruitment as per the OM of DP No 1/22/2005-OR-III/DP dated 18<sup>th</sup> September 2021, other terms notified earlier remaining the same:

- i) Written test would consist of one paper of 100 nos of Multiple-Choice Type Questions each carrying 1 mark for correct answer with a total of 100 marks
- ii) Duration of the test would be three hours.
- iii) There would be no negative marks for incorrect answers or questions not attempted.
- iv) Scheme of the examination for recruitment to Group -III posts will be i) General Intelligence and Reasoning (25 marks), ii) General Knowledge (25 marks) iii) English Language (25 marks) and iv) Quantitative Aptitude (25 marks).

2. Modified General Instruction and Indicative Syllabus for both the post of Research Assistants (RAs) and Research Investigators (RIs) is at Annexure-I.

3. Date of examination and centre of examinations will be indicated on the Admit Card to be issued (to eligible candidates who have applied earlier) from 19<sup>th</sup> September 2022 at the Receipt/Issue counter of Secretariat Planning Department, Babupara.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND INDICATIVE SYLLABUS FOR WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS FOR THE POST OF RESEARCH ASSISTANTS (RAs) AND RESEARCH INVESTIGATORS (RIs) IN PLANNING DEPARTMENT

1. INDICATIVE SYLLABUS of graduate level:

1.2 GENERAL KNOWLEDGE ( 25 marks):

Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's General Awareness of the environment and its relevance to the society. The questions will also be designed to test knowledge of the current events and of such matters of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The test will include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries, state of Manipur especially pertaining to History, Indian Polity & Constitution, Art & Culture, Geography, Economics, General Policy, Science and Scientific Research, National/International Organisations/Institutions, events etc.

1.3 GENERAL ENGLISH ( 25 marks):

In addition to the testing of candidate's understanding of the English, its Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc would be tested.

1.4 GENERAL INTELLIGENCE AND REASONING ( 25 marks)

2. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EXAMINATION:

- i. Total marks for both the examination for RA and RI is 100 (Quantitative Aptitude-25, General English-25 and General English -25 and General Intelligence -25)
- ii. Total allotted time for examination will be 3 hours.
- iii. The written test would consist of 1(one) paper of 100 nos of Multiple -choice Type Questions each carrying 1 mark for correct answer with a total of 100 marks.
- iv. There would be no negative marking for incorrect answers or questions not attempted.
- v. All questions will have four answers with one correct answer.
- vi. Only one answer is to be selected/ ticked for a question. If two or more answers are selected/ ticked for a question, the answer will be treated as wrong answer.
- vii. If a question has no correct answer, by mistake, then full mark (1 mark) will be awarded for all candidates.
- viii. If a question has more than one correct answer, by chance, then full mark (1 mark) will be awarded for all candidates selecting one of them as their answer.
- ix. If two or more candidates scores same mark, ranking will be determined based on seniority of date of birth.

Note: General Instructions and Indicative syllabus are same for both posts
