No.APR-2/1/2025-DP-DP: As per Rule-16(2) of AIS (Conduct) Rules, 1968 and as instructed vide Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs letter No.45020/14/2016-IPS-II dated 13/12/2016 and No.45020/20/2024-IPS.II dated 11/12/2024, All Indian Police Services (IPS) of Manipur Cadre shall file Immovable Property Returns (IPRs) online in the prescribed form by 31st January of every years in respect of the previous year ending 31st December in the IPR Module. Failure to ensure timely submission of IPR would result in denial of Vigilance Clearance and timely submission of IPR has been mandatory for appointment in the next level of pay in the pay matrix vide notification dated 30/12/2021 under Rule 3(1) of IPS(Pay) Amendment Rules, 2021.

2. Taking into consideration of the above, all IPS officers of the State Cadre are hereby requested for strict compliance and timely filing of IPR.
