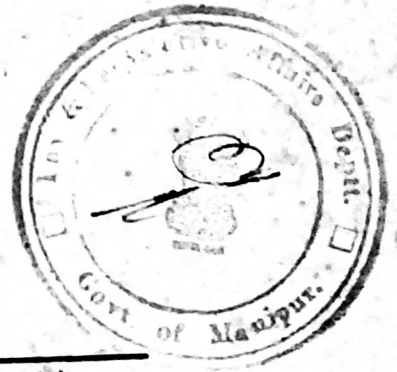

No. 3/1/72-CON—In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (2) and (3) of Article 166 of the Constitution and in supersession of the existing rules and orders on the subject, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be called the Business of the Government of Manipur (Allocation) Rules, 1972 and shall come into force with immediate effect.

2. The entire Business of the Government shall be transacted in the Departments of Manipur, specified in the Schedule, and shall be classified and distributed between those Departments as laid down therein.

3. The Governor, shall, in consultation with the Chief Minister, allocate to the Ministers the Business of the Government by assigning one or more Departments to the charge of a Minister:

Provided that nothing in this rule shall prevent the assignment of one Department to the charge of more than one Minister.

4. There shall be a Secretary for each Department who shall be the official Head of the Department:

Provided that—

- (a) more than one Department may be placed in charge of the same Secretary;
- (b) the work of the Department may be divided between two or more Secretaries.

No. 3/3/72-Act/L.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 299 of the Constitution, the Governor of Manipur hereby directs that the undermentioned contracts and assurances of property made in exercise of the executive power of the State may be executed on his behalf as follows:—

1. All deeds and instruments relating to matters other than those specified in items 2 to 7 below ; by the Governor or any other officer authorised to authenticate orders and other instruments made and executed in the name of the Governor in accordance with rules made under clause (2) of article 166 of the Constitution.
2. Deeds, contracts and other instruments in matter connected with the sale of forest produce of all kinds if the amount or value does not in any case exceed Rs. 2,000/-; by the Deputy Conservator of Forest, Manipur.
3. Deeds, contracts and other instruments relating to :—
  - (i) execution of minor works for the Police Department not under the Public Works Department, and
  - (ii) supply of articles and medicines for use by the Manipur Rifles and any matters following within his ordinary jurisdiction by the commanding officer of the Battalion concerned.
4. Contracts for supply of articles for use in Jail or regarding the sale of articles manufactured in Jail ; by the Inspector General of Prisons.
5. Contracts for supply of articles and medicines for use in Hospitals ; by the Director of Medical, Health and Family Planning Services.
6. Contracts and other instruments relating to the Public Works Department; by Executive Engineers and by Assistant Engineers, where the value in each case does not exceed Rs. 5,000.00.
7. Deeds and contracts for the supply of articles and execution of minor works not under the Public Works Department, required for use of any department and other instruments connected with the administration of that departments ; by the Head of the Department concerned.

Imphal, the 21st January, 1972

No. 3/30/71-Act/L—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 79 of the North Eastern Areas (Re-Organisation) Act, 1971 (81 of 1971) the Governor of Manipur has been pleased to make the following order to facilitate the application of laws in their application to the State of Manipur, namely:—

1. (1) This order may be called the Manipur (Adaptation of Laws) Order, 1972.
- (2) It shall come into force on the 21st January, 1972.
2. The General Clauses Act, 1897 applies for the interpretation of this order.
3. The laws mentioned in the Schedule to this Order shall, until altered, repealed or amended by a competent legislature or other competent authority, have effect subject to the adaptation and modifications directed in that Schedule.

### SCHEDULE

#### THE EASTERN BENGAL & ASSAM EXCISE ACT, 1910 AS EXTENDED TO MANIPUR

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Section 79, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to make the following Orders, namely :-

1. (1) This order may be called the Manipur (Adaptation of Laws) (No.2) order, 1972.  
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. The General Clauses Act, 1897, applies for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of a Central Act.

The provisions of this Order which adapt any Rules Regulations, bye-laws, etc. in their application to Manipur so as to alter the manner in which, or in accordance with which, or the authority by which, any powers are exercisable, shall not render invalid any notification, order, licence, permission, award, commitment, attachment, duly made or issued, or any thing duly done before the commencement of this Order; and any such notification, order, licence, permission, award, commitment, attachment or thing may be revoked, varied or undone in like manner, to the like extent and in the like circumstances as if it had been made, issued or done after the commencement of this Order by the competent authority under and in accordance with the provisions then applicable to such a case.
