NOTIFICATION
Issued, the 13th January, 1983.

No.1/60/79-RR/DP: In supersession of all previous rules in this regard and in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Sub-Inspector(Enforcement) in the Motor Vehicles Department, Manipur, as shown in the MPSC Form-8, namely :-

1. Short title :- These rules may be called the Motor Vehicles Department, Manipur/Sub-Inspector(Enforcement)/Recruitment Rules, 1983.

2. Application :- These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the MPSC Form-8 hereto annexed.

3. Classification, scale of pay, method of recruitment etc. :- Classification of the said post, scale of pay, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 3 to 13 of the MPSC Form-8.

4. Disqualification :- (a) No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life-time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the aforesaid post, and

(b) no woman, whose marriage is void by reason of husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Manipur may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. "Power to relax - Where the Governor is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms(Personnel Division), Government of Manipur, for relaxation of any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts".

6. These rules shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Manipur Gazette.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF SUB-INSPECTOR (ENFORCEMENT)
IN THE MOTOR VEHICLES DEPARTMENT, MANIPUR.

1. Designation of post. : Sub-Inspector (Enforcement).
2. Number of posts. : 10 (ten).
3. Classification. : G.C.S. Class-III (Non-Gazetted).
4. Scale of pay. : Rs. 325-15-430-EB-17-566-EB-18-710/-
(Pre-revised).
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post. : Selection.
6. Age for direct recruits. : 30 years and below
(Upper age limit relaxable for SCs/STs candidates by 5 years and by 10 years for Government servants appointed on regular basis under the Government of Manipur and by 15 years for those Government servants who belong to SCs/STs).
7. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits. : ESSENTIAL:
 1. Graduate of any recognised University.
 2. Knowledge of Manipuri.
 3. Height 5 ft. 4 inches. (Minimum).
 4. Minimum Chest Measurements 31"-33".

DESIRABLE:

Knowledge of Hindi.
8. Whether age & educational qualification prescribed for the direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees. : N.A.
9. Period of probation, if any. : 2 Years.
(Drawal of 2nd. increment is subject to passing the prescribed Departmental M.V. Enforcement Training & Examination conducted by Police Training Centre).

10. Method of recruitment; whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer & percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.

50% by Promotion
&
50% by Direct Recruitment.

11. In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer to be made.

PROMOTION:

Assistant Sub-Inspector (Enforcement) of Motor Vehicles Department having 2 (two) years regular service in the grade in the case of Graduate and 3 (three) years regular service in the grade in the case of Matriculate and 7 (seven) years regular service in the grade in the case of Under-Matric.

NOTES:- 1. Where a person is considered for such appointment all persons possessing qualifications and who are senior to him in the grade shall also be considered irrespective of the fact whether or not they fulfil the requirement as to minimum period of qualifying service.

2. Any period of adhoc appointment prior to regularisation shall not be counted in the minimum period of service prescribed for promotion.
