NOTIFICATION Imphal, the 20th September, 2021

No. RRDP-44/2/2020-DP-DP: In supersession of all previous rules issued in this regard and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Inspector (Taxes)** in the Transport Department, Government of Manipur as shown in the M.P.S.C. Form-8, namely :-

1. **Short title:-** These rules may be called the Transport Department, Government of Manipur Inspector (Taxes) Recruitment Rules, 2021.
2. **Application:-** These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the M.P.S.C. Form-8 hereto annexed.
3. **Classification, Scale of pay, method of recruitment etc.:-** Classification of the said post, scale of pay, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in the columns 3 to 13 of the said MPSC Form-8.
4. **Disqualifications :-**
 - (a) No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the aforesaid post, and
 - (b) No woman, whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Manipur may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
5. "Power to relax - Where the Governor is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Manipur Public Service Commission, for relaxation of any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts."
6. These rules shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Manipur Gazette.

**RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF INSPECTOR (TAXES) IN
 THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT, MANIPUR**

1.	Designation of Post(s).	Inspector (Taxes)
2.	No. of Post(s).	11 (Eleven).
3.	Classification.	G.C.S. Group-B (Non-Gazetted)
4.	Scale of pay.	Rs. 9,300-34,800 + Grade Pay Rs. 4,200/- [As prescribed in MS(RP) Rules, 2019]
5.	Whether selection post or non-selection post.	Selection
6.	Age for direct recruits.	Minimum : 18 years, Maximum : 38 years (Upper age limit is relaxable for Govt. servants appointed under the Government of Manipur to the extent of the period of continuous services put in the post/service and by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and by 3 years for OBC candidates and a Government servant who belongs to SC/ST will get the facility admissible to a Government servant in addition to the relaxation admissible to SC/ST candidates).
7.	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits	Essential : Degree with Economics/Maths/Statistics OR B. Com. with advanced Accountancy from a recognised University. Desirable: Knowledge of Manipuri & Hindi
8.	Whether age and educational qualification prescribed for the direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees	N.A.
9.	Period of probation, if any.	2 (two years)
10.	Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.	By promotion failing which by direct recruitment.

11.	In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer to be made.	Promotion: S.I. (Taxes) in the Motor Vehicles Deptt. with at least 4 (four) years regular service in the grade. Notes:- (1) The promotes should fulfil the condition of qualifying service for promotion provided that where a person is considered for such appointment all persons who possess requisite qualification and who are senior to him in the grade shall also be considered irrespective of the fact whether or not they fulfil the requirement as to the minimum period of qualifying service for the purpose of promotion mentioned above. (2) Any period of ad-hoc appointment prior to regularisation of the appointment in consultation with Commission shall not be counted towards the minimum period of service prescribed for promotion.
12.	If a DPC exists, what is its composition.	Class-II D.P.C.
13.	Circumstances in which MPSC is to be consulted in making recruitment.	As required under MPSC (Exemption from consultation) Regulations, 1972.
