NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 3rd December, 2025

No.RRDP-10/4/2025-DP-DP: In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Special Primary Teacher** in the Department of Education (School), Manipur, as shown in the M.P.S.C. Form-8, namely:-

1. **Short title:** - These rules may be called the Department of Education(School), Manipur [Special Primary Teacher] Recruitment Rules, 2025.

2. **Application:** - These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the M.P.S.C. Form-8 hereto annexed.

3. **Classification, Scale of pay, method of recruitment etc:** - Classification of the said post, scale of pay, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in the columns 3 to 13 of the said MPSC Form-8.

4. **Disqualifications:** -

(a) No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the aforesaid post, and

(b) No woman, whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Manipur may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **"Power to relax"** - Where the Governor is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms (Personnel Division), Government of Manipur for relaxation of any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts."

6. These rules shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Manipur Gazette.

**RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF SPECIAL PRIMARY TEACHER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF
EDUCATION (SCHOOL), MANIPUR.**

1.	Designation of the Post (s)	Special Primary Teacher
2.	No. of Post (s)	627 (six hundred and twenty seven)
3.	Classification	GCS Group-C (Non-Gazetted)
4.	Scale of pay	L-6, L-8 (Sr. Scale after 12 years of regular service in the grade) L-9 (SG Scale after 12 years of regular service in Sr. Scale @ 10% of the No. in Sr. Scale)
5.	Whether Selection post or Non-Selection Post	Selection
6.	Age for Direct Recruits	Upper age limit: - 38 (thirty-eight) years and below (Upper age limit is relaxable for Govt. servants appointed under the Govt. of Manipur to the extent of the period of continuous services put in the post/service and by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and by 3 years for OBC candidates and a Govt. Servant who belongs to SC/ST will get the facility admissible to a Govt. servant in additional to the relaxation admissible to SC/ST candidates). Relaxation of age shall be applicable to different kinds of candidates as per Government Order/Oms etc. issued from time to time.
7.	Educational and other qualifications required for Direct Recruits	Essential: 10+2 (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks from a recognised University/ Board. Or 10+2 (or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks from a recognised University/Institution/Board, in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulation 2002. - D.Ed. in Special Education from RCI Approved Institute and possess a valid RCI CRR number. Or D.El.Ed. with a recognised qualification (Certificate/ Diploma RCI marks effort to design and conduct such Training programme through its approved institution for in service/pre-service general teachers from a RCI approved institution equivalent to D.Ed. in Special Education and possess a valid RCI CRR number. - Six-month training of teaching in cross disability area in inclusive education, if the proposed programme (cross disability/top up courses being developed by RCI as an in-service training) is not available the same may be dropped from the qualifications with a condition that the recruited with D.Ed./B.Ed. Special Education or Equivalent qualifications have to compulsorily under aforesaid training as soon as the same is conducted. - Passed in the Teacher Eligibility Test-I (TET-I) conducted by the State Govt. or any other agency approved by NCTE.

9.	Period of Probation, if any	2(two) years
