No.26/4/2020-M : In supersession of all the existing Rules in this regard, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to make the following Rules viz:- THE MANIPUR MBBS/BDS/BASLP (Selection of Candidates for Nomination) Rules, 2021.

CHAPTER-I
PRELIMINARY

1. *Short Title & Commencement:-*

- i. These Rules may be called "*THE MANIPUR MBBS/BDS/BASLP SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR NOMINATION RULES, 2021.*"
- ii. They shall come into force from the date of its publication in the official gazette of Manipur.

2. *Definition :-* In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires :-

- i "Government" means the Government of Manipur.
- ii "Selection Board" means the Selection Board constituted under Rule 3.
- iii "Director" means the Director of Health Services, Manipur.
- iv "*Scheduled Tribes*" means the Scheduled Tribes specified in respect of the State of Manipur under Scheduled Tribes Order, 1950.
- v "*Schedule Castes*" means the Scheduled Castes specified in respect of the State of Manipur in the Constitution under scheduled Castes order, 1950.
- vi "*Meritorious Sportsperson*" means a candidate who had represented the State of Manipur as competitor in the National Sports Championship of Sub-Junior Category, Junior Category, Senior Category conducted under the auspices of the National Sports Federations recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India or All India School Championship under the auspices of the School Games Federation of India or inter University Championship under the auspices of the National Sports Promotion Organization or who had represented India as a competitor at the International Sports Championship as selected/deputed by the concerned National Sports Federation recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India only for the Sports disciplines approved by the Department of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of Manipur from time to time.
- vii "*Available Seats*" mean the seats available for each course of MBBS, BDS and BASLP in an academic year for nomination by the Government for admission in the first year of MBBS, BDS and BASLP Courses in the Medical Colleges in India.

- viii *Qualifying Examination*” means NEET or any equivalent Examination which , in scope and standard, is equivalent to NEET conducted by the Competent Authority from time to time .
 - ix *Specialists*” means a registered Medical Practitioner with a recognized Post Graduate qualification.
 - x *“Special Medical board”* means a Board of Medical Specialists with the Director Health Services, Manipur as Chairman and all the Specialists as Member.
3. For the purpose of these rules there shall be a Selection Board consisting of the following :-
- i Administrative Secretary (Health), Government of Manipur. - Chairman
 - ii Director of Health Services, Manipur. - Member Secretary
 - iii A Gazetted Officer to be nominated by the Government of Manipur - Member

CHAPTER – II

METHOD OF NOMINATION: ELIGIBILITY & DISQUALIFICATION.

4. *Method of Nomination: -*
Selection of candidates to the available seats shall be done by the Selection Board in accordance with the provisions of these Rules and the Director Health Services, Manipur will issue nomination letter of the selected candidates.
5. *Selection of Candidates for nomination:-*
Application will be invited from the NEET (UG) or Equivalent Examination qualified and eligible candidates for Open Counselling for selection and nomination of candidates, to be conducted on such date, place and time as specified in a notification by the Director Medical and Health Services, Manipur in this behalf.
6. *Eligibility & Qualification to appear in the Open Counselling :*
- i. In order to be eligible to appear at the Open Counselling, a candidate must :-
 - a. Have been a domicile of Manipur by birth or either of his parents has been continuously residing in Manipur for a period of not less than 50 years prior to the date of publication of this Rule or is in the service of the Government of Manipur or an Institution/ Organization which is a body substantially owned or controlled by the Govt. of Manipur.
 - b. Be a candidate must be NEET (UG) or Equivalent Examination qualified for the academic year.
 - 6. c. Have completed the age of 17 years on or before the 31st December of the year of admission to the MBBS / BDS/BASLP courses.
In respect of the BDS seats at RDC, Guwahati, the candidate must have completed the age of 17 years but not more than 24 years on 31st December of the year of admission (upper age) relaxable by 3 years in respect of SC/ST candidates.
 - d. Have applied for the state corresponding to his/her domicile.
7. i. In case any candidate is found to have submitted false information or forged certificate in his/her Application Form, he/she shall be debarred from selection without prior intimation to the candidate;
- ii. Any attempt on the part of the candidate to obtain support his/her candidature by any unfair and illegal means shall disqualify him/her from candidature without prior intimation to the candidate.
 - iii. The decision of the Selection Board as to the eligibility or selection of the candidate for admission to the MBBS/BDS/ BASLP Courses shall be final.
 - iv. Candidate/s without Acknowledgement card issued in this regard will not be allowed to attend Open counselling/s.

8. Candidate shall be qualified for nomination under these rules if:-
- i. He/she is certified by a Medical Officer having a degree of not less than MBBS, to be in good mental or physical health and free from any mental or physical defect likely to interfere with Medical studies and profession;
 - ii. He/she has not been found, by any competent court, guilty of misconduct or convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude;
 - iii. He/she fulfills the conditions prescribed by the institute/college for eligibility to admission. If a nominated candidate is refused admission by an Institute due to non-fulfillment of certain admission requirements, he/she will not have any claim for his/her transfer of nomination/admission to some other Institution/college.

CHAPTER -III
COMPETITIVE TEST EXAMINATION

9. The State of Manipur will not conduct a separate Entrance Examination for Selection and nomination of candidates for admission into the available seats of MBBS/BDS/ BASLP Courses. The Directorate of Health services, Manipur will prepare a Merit List of Candidates for the state of Manipur based on the score of the NEET or any other equivalent examination of the academic year conducted by a Competent Authority from time to time.

CHAPTER - IV
OPEN COUNSELLING

10. The Counselling authority for selection and nomination of candidates under this Rule shall be the Selection Board. Venue, date and time of Open Counselling shall be notified from time to time as instructed by National Medical Council (NMC) or any other Competent Authority prevailing during that period.
11. **Application Form:-**Application in a prescribed form for the Counselling in Annexure-I shall be obtained from the Office of the Director of Medical and Health Services on payment of requisite Fees approved by the Government from time to time.
12. Application from for Open Counselling should reach the office of the Director of Medical and Health Services, Manipur by such date as the Government may, from time to time.
13. The following documents shall be enclosed along with the Application Form, namely:
- i. Two recent passport size photographs of the candidate duly self-attested or attested by a Gazetted Officer to be affixed, one each, in the application form and acknowledgement card
 - ii. Photostat copies of Certificate, mark sheet of XII or equivalent examinations passed from a recognized University or Board or other Institution duly self-attested or attested by a Gazette Officer;
 - iii. A photostat copy of the certificate or admit card of HSLC/Equivalent Examination from a recognized Board duly self-attested or attested by a Gazetted Officer as proof of age.
 - iv. A photostat copy of certificate of character from the Principal of the College/School last attended;
 - v. Children of Ex-Servicemen have to produce a certificate from the Secretary, Rajya Sainik Board, Imphal to the effect that they are the wards of Ex-servicemen. Similarly, the Children of the armed Forces Personnel have to produce a certificate from the Commanding Officers of the Units/Battalions in which either of the parents is serving.
 - vi. Certificate of domicile from the Deputy Commissioner or an officer authorized by D.C. for the purpose, of the District to which the candidate belongs, in the proforma attached to the application form or a certificate from the Head of Department to prove that the parent is in service of the Government of Manipur, or an Institution which is a body substantially owned or controlled by the Govt. of Manipur.

- vii In case of Schedule Castes or Schedule Tribes, a certificate in that behalf from the District Magistrate or an officer authorized by D.C. for the purpose, of the District to which the Candidate belongs shall be enclosed.
 - viii Certificate of fitness for undergoing medical course from a registered medical practitioner holding a qualification not less than MBBS degree.
 - ix In case of meritorious sportspersons, photocopies of certificates for participating in National Level Sports Championship or International Level sports Championship, as the case may be, issued by the Competent Authority duly attested by the Director of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of Manipur.
 - x In case of People With Disability (PWD) candidates, the degree and nature of disability certificate issued by a Board approved and recognized by the Government of Manipur.
 - xi In case of Other Backward Classes, a valid certificate in that behalf from DC or an officer authorized by D.C. of the District concerned to which the candidates belong.
 - xii In case of Economically Weaker section (EWS) candidates, a valid certificate in that behalf from the D.C. or an officer authorized by D.C. of the District concerned to which the candidates belong.
 - xiii A photostat copy of NEET score card duly self-attested or attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- 14 To be eligible for the seats reserved for the PWD candidates, the degree and nature of disability will be assessed by the Special medical board on the date, time and venue fixed from time to time prior to open counselling.
 - 15 A candidate may authorize a mentally sound person not below the age of 18 years, to attend the Counselling/s in his/her absence. The decision of the authorized attendant will be treated as his/her decision. A prescribed Format for authorization is available at the Directorate of Medical and Health Services, Manipur. Any claim against the decision of the authorized attendant shall not be entertained in any circumstances.
 - 16 Candidate or his/her authorized attendant should bring all the relevant certificates in original at the time of open Counselling, otherwise his/her candidature will be forfeited and no further claim will be entertained.
 - 17 A Candidate or his/her authorized attendant who fail to attend/report in time in the previous counseling will not be allowed to attend subsequent Counselling/s.
 - 18 *The list of Games/Sports which qualify for Meritorious Sportsperson's quota for nomination for MBBS/BDS/BASLP course is as approved by the Department of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of Manipur from time to time.*
 19. **Select List and Wait List:**
 - i. The Directorate, Medical and Health Services, Manipur shall prepare a common merit list of candidates based on the score of NEET or any other equivalent examination prevailing during the period,
 - ii There shall be separate Select List of each category equal to the number of available seats of each category and Waiting List for Candidates of each category belonging to Unreserved (UR), Other Backward Classes (OBC), Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Economically Weaker Section (EWS), Meritorious Sportspersons and Children of Armed Forces Personnel/Ex-Servicemen, Person with Disability (PwD) etc.

Provided that the EWS candidates shall have their claim as and when seats are increased by the appropriate authority in terms of the Government of India Office Memorandum No. F. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January, 2019.

Provide Further that Persons belonging to EWS selected against the quota for persons with benchmark disabilities/ Ex-serviceman shall be place against the roster points earmarked for EWS [as per Office Memorandum No. 36039/1/2019-Estt(Res), Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Personnel & Training dated 31st January, 2029]

- iii After the select list, all the remaining candidates will be treated as in waiting list of the respective category.
- iv The Select List and the Waiting List so prepared shall be submitted to the Government for approval.

20 Allotment of seat/course/college :

- i Allotment of seats/course/college to the candidate whose name is appeared in the select list prepared under Rule 19 shall be done by the selection board through an Open Counselling. The Venue and date of such Counselling shall be notified to the candidates/public at least one week before the date so appointed through print and electronic media, DDK and AIR. On the day notified for personal appearance, the seats available for allotment shall be suitably displayed on the Notice board. No seat shall be allowed to a candidate unless he/she or his/her authorized representatives appear before the Selection Board on the day of open Counselling along with all relevant Certificates in original. Any claim for seat/course/college without original certificates shall not be entertained.
- ii Two hundred points roster will be adopted for allotment of seats.
- iii Allotment will be done strictly on merit basis. Candidate in the higher rank will be given the chance to select his/her choice earlier than the candidate in lower rank.
- iv Allotment candidates to the available seats will be in the following order
 1. RIMS
 2. JNIMS and
 3. Outside Medical Colleges (if available)
- v Allotment of seats for the current academic year will be in continuation with the roster point of the previous year.
- vi Similarly, strictly based on merit, candidates in the Waiting List shall be considered by the Selection Board for nomination against the available seat/s which may arise from any sources
- vii A candidate shall appear in person at the time open counselling. Provided that a candidate who is unable to appear at time open counselling for any reason
 - a. Authorized representative with an authority letter and undertaking (Annexure IV) duly signed by him or her can attend the open counselling for allotment of seat.
 - b. Only one authorized person shall represent one candidate only
- viii At the time of personal appearance for allotment of seat, the candidate or his/her authorized representative shall have the option to either:
 - a. Select any one of the available seats based on merit
 - b. Reject the available seat/seats and abjure the claim for a seat under the Government quota.

The candidate/authorized representative shall have to fill up a form of Undertaking Annexure-V) at the time of personal appearance for the selection/rejection of a seat. The candidate allotted a seat, the allotment letter shall be issued on the same day to the person who appears before the open counseling.
- ix Wherever open counseling could not be held due to unavoidable circumstances on the day so fixed for counseling, the re-schedule the date, time and place of such counseling shall be notified through print and electronic media.
- x The conditions relating to the start of session/deposit and refund of fee and other charges/execution of bond/services in rural/tribal area, etc., if any shall be as per rules and regulations of the respective College/University/State Government

- xii The candidates who have been allotted seats and have joined the allotted colleges may apply for reallocation of course/college, if interested. They should send their applications for reallocation along with prescribed undertaking (Annexure-VI) duly forwarded by the Principal/Dean of the allotted colleges by registered post/speed post/hand to the Director, Health Services, Manipur on or before the date of the concerned allotment by Open Counselling. Any application received late on any account, including postal delay shall not be considered for reallocation of course/college. The Director, Health Services, Manipur shall not be responsible for late receipt of the application.
 - xiii Applications for change of course/college duly forwarded by any person other than Dean/Principal will be summarily rejected. In case of officiating Dean / Principal, the applications should be countersigned by the head of the administration of the Institution.
 - xiv The candidate who comes for reallocation has to complete the above formalities, failing which he / she shall not be allowed for reallocation. On reallocation, the earlier allotment of course/college shall stand automatically cancelled with immediate effect and the candidate shall have no claim whatsoever on the earlier allotments.
 - xv Candidates/authorized representatives for reallocation must bring the admission slip and admission fee receipts as a proof of admission to the earlier allotted college.
 - xvi Any candidate who had surrendered a seat/course is not allowed to claim a similar seat/course later, in that academic year.
 - xvii The reserved category candidates who are selected on the same standard as applied to General category will not be adjusted against reserved vacancy (vide Department of Personnel and Training, Establishment (Reservation-1) Section OM No. 36012/2/96- Estt. (Res) dated 02/07/1997.
 - xviii If a relaxed standard is applied in selecting a reserved candidate, for example in the age limit, experience, qualification, permitted number of chances in the written examination, etc such candidates will be counted against the reserved vacancies.
- 21 Reservation of MBBS/BDS/BASLP seats:
- i The Government shall reserve seats for Scheduled Cast, Scheduled Tribes and Other backward Classes [excluding the creamy layer of the Other Backward Classes as defined vide Government of Manipur, Department of personnel's letter No.9/1/90 (OBC)/DP dated 02-08-2004 read with GOI: DP & TRG's O.M. No.36033/3/2004-Estt (Res) dated 09-03-2004]as per policy of the State Government from time to time in force.
 - ii The Government shall reserve two MBBS or BDS seats for the Children of Armed Forces Personnel/Ex-servicemen for nomination against the seat as opted by the selected candidates who would be placed in the appropriate categories – General, Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (excluding the creamy layer of the Other Backward as defined vide Government of Manipur, Department of personnel's letter No.9/1/90 (OBC)/DP dated 02-08-2004 read with GOI: DP & TRG's O.M. No.36033/3/2004-Estt (Res) dated 09-03-2004) by making adjustment within the quotas available for each category.

Provided that the number of MBBS or BDS seats reserved for children of Armed Forces Personnel/Ex-servicemen shall be one MBBS or BDS seat if the total number of available MBBS/BDS seats are not above 100(one hundred) seats.

- iii The Government shall reserve two MBBS or BDS seats for the Meritorious Sports person for nomination against the seat as opted by the selected candidates who would be placed in the appropriate categories – General, Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (excluding the creamy layer of the Other Backward Classes as defined vide Government of Manipur, Department of personnel's letter No.9/1/90 (OBC)/DP dated 02-08-2004 read with GOI: DP & TRG's O.M. No.36033/3/2004-Estt (Res) dated 09-03-2004) by making adjustment within the quotas available for each category.
- iv The Government shall reserve 5% of the total available seats of MBBS/BDS/BASLP allotted in a year to the State of Manipur for persons with disability of the following types and percentage of disability for nomination against the seats as opted by the selected candidate who would be placed in the appropriate categories- General, Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes [excluding the creamy layer of the Other Backward Classes as defined vide Government of Manipur, Department of personnel's letter No.9/1/90(OBC)/DP dated 02-08-2004 read with GOI:DP & TRG's O.M.No.36033/3/2004-Estt(Res) dated 09-03-2004] by making adjustment within the quota available for each category.

- 22 In the event of sufficient number of candidates belonging to the categories provided for children of Armed Forces Personnel, Meritorious Sports persons, or persons with disability not being available such vacancies shall be filled up on merit basis after distributing such resultant vacancies for the un-reserved and reserved categories for ST & SC on a pro-rata basis as per the policy of the State Government in force from time to time.
- 23 Instruction to Candidates as given in Annexure-II will be issued to candidates along with prescribed Application Forms for guidance and strict compliance

Chapter V

24. *Power to remove difficulties:-* If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of these Rules, the Government may take such remedial measures not inconsistent with the provisions of these rules as may be necessary or expedient for removing such difficulty.
