NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 20th January, 2026

RRDP-27/2/2025-DP-DP :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Manipur Health Services Rules, 1982 namely-

1. Short title and commencement. —

(i) *These Rules may be called “Manipur Health Services (Amendment) Rules, 2026”.*

(ii) *These Rules shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.*

2. Substitution of Rule 13A: For Rule 13A of the Manipur Health Services Rules, 1982, the following shall be substituted, namely,—

“13A. Training:-

(1) A person appointed to the MHS Service may be considered for sponsorship with entitlement of Study Leave against Sponsored Category seats and also for permission with entitlement of Extra Ordinary Leave against Open Category seats for undergoing higher Post Graduate Medical Courses for a maximum of 3(three) years duration subject to the following conditions:

- i. *He/she has completed 2 (two) years regular service (including the period of probation);*
- ii. *He/she may be sponsored for PG studies against sponsored Category seats or he/she may be given permitted for PG studies against Open Category Seats only for PG Qualifications included in the Annexure to Schedule II to Manipur Health Service Rules, 1982 as amended from time to time & are in actual demand or in shortage in the service. Recommendation and issue of sponsorship certificate or “NOC” for the PG studies may be strictly adhered to the assessed needs.*
- iii. *Upon selection, he/she may be sponsored or permitted for the PG medical courses if the total number of members of the service, including the applicant, is equal or below the total number of sanctioned Training Reserve Posts;*
- iv. *He/she has executed a service BOND undertaking to compulsorily serve the Government for a period of 5 (five) years in respect of the member nominated against sponsored category seats with study leave entitlement or, a service BOND undertaking to*

compulsorily serve the Government for a period of 3(three) years in respect of the member permitted against Open Category seats with entitlement of Extra-Ordinary Leave from the date of returning to duty after completion of PG studies,

- v. *He/she is not due to reach the age of superannuation from Government service before compulsorily serving the Government for a period equivalent to the service BOND period from the expected date of returning to duty after completion of the Post Graduate Medical Course;*
- vi. *The bond amount shall be equivalent to the total gross salaries actually drawn by the member nominated against sponsored category seats with Study leave entitlement or, the total gross salaries that would be drawn by the leave substitute of member permitted/selected against Open Category seats with Extra-Ordinary Leave entitlement;*
- vii. *Any failure to pay the payable BOND amount in time shall invite payment of the amount with interest for the period of delay in payment @ saving bank deposit interest rates.*

(2) A Member of the Service, who has availed 3 (three) years Study leave or Extra-Ordinary Leave as the case may be for completing PG studies as a sponsored candidate or non-sponsored candidate, may also be considered for sponsorship for study leave or for permission with entitlement of Extra Ordinary Leave against Open Category seats for pursuing Post Doctoral–Super-specialist medical courses or Medical Ph.D programme in subject/specialty for a maximum of 3 (three) years subject to the following conditions :

- i. *He/she has rendered 2 (two) years continuous service under the Government after returning from previous P.G. studies.*
- ii. *He/she may be sponsored against sponsored category or permitted against open category seats only for PG Qualifications included in the Annexure to Schedule II to Manipur Health Service Rules, 1982 as amended from time to time & are in actual demand or in shortage in the service. Recommendation and issue of sponsorship certificate or NOC for the super-specialist courses may be strictly adhered to assessed needs;*
- iii. *Upon selection, he/she may be sponsored or permitted for the super-specialist courses if the total number of members of the service, including the applicant, is equal or below the total number of sanctioned Training Reserved Posts.*
- iv. *He/she has executed a service **BOND** undertaking to compulsorily serve the Government for another period of 5 (five) years in respect of the member nominated against sponsored category seats with study leave entitlement or, a service **BOND** undertaking to compulsorily serve the Government for another period of 3(three) years in respect of the member permitted/selected against Open Category seats with entitlement of Extra-Ordinary Leave from the date of returning to duty after completion of the Post Doctoral Super-specialist medical course. And, this compulsory service BOND period shall be in addition to the service BOND period remaining to be rendered after returning from the earlier P.G. studies.*
- v. *He/she is not due to reach the age of superannuation from Government service before compulsorily serving the Government for a period equivalent to the cumulative service BOND period for previous P.G. studies and ensuing Post Doctoral Super-speciality studies after returning from the Post-Doctoral Super-specialist studies.*
- vi. *The BOND amount shall be equivalent to the total gross salaries actually drawn by the member nominated against sponsored category seats and completed the course on study leave or, total gross salaries that would be drawn by the leave substitute of member*

- permitted/selected against Open Category seats and completed the course on extra-ordinary leave.*
- vii. *If he/she fails to render the full cumulative period of compulsory service BOND after returning from the Post Graduate Super-specialist course, he/she shall pay 1.5 (one and half) times the Bond amount.*
- viii. *Any failure to pay the payable BOND amount in time shall invite payment of the amount with interest for the period of delay in payment @ saving bank deposit interest rates.*

Note:-“Higher” study implies undergoing a post graduate medical course that is a level above the highest medical qualification, as the case may be, of the member of the Service.”

3. Substitution of Schedule I:- The existing Schedule I to Manipur Health Services Rules, 1982 as amended from time to time shall be substituted by the following:-
