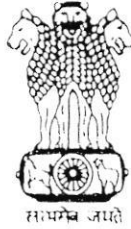

NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 10th October, 2016

No. 25/1/94-M (Pt. II)A: The Governor of Manipur is pleased to make the following rules to further amend the "Manipur General Nursing, Female Health Workers & Male Health Workers Entrance Examination (Selection of Candidates) Rules, 1994 namely:

"Manipur General Nursing, Female Health Workers & Male Health Workers Entrance Examination (Selection of Candidate) (Sixth Amendment) Rule, 2016"

1. Short title & commencement:

- (i) These rules may be called the Manipur General Nursing, Female Health Workers and Male Health Workers Entrance Examination (Selection of Candidates) (Sixth Amendment) Rules, 2016.
- (ii) They shall come into force with effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment of Rule 3:

The existing Rule 3 shall be substituted by the following:-

"For the purpose of these Rules, there shall be a common Selection Board for General Nursing, Female Health Workers and Male Health Workers consisting of the following:

3. Amendment of Rule 5:

The existing Rule 5 shall be substituted by the following:

"For selection of candidates for nomination, the Selection Board shall hold and conduct combined competitive test for General Nursing, Female Health Workers and Male Health Workers (hereinafter referred to as the Competitive Test) on such date, place and time as specified in a Notification by the Government in the following manner:

- (a) The Selection Board shall first prepare a separate select list for General Nursing Course in order of merit from amongst the candidates, based on the result of the combined competitive test for selection of the candidates to the number of seats available.
- (b) Similarly, the Selection Board shall prepare a separate select list for Female Health Workers Training Course in order of merit, based on the result of the combined competitive test for nomination of candidates to the number of seats available for Female Health Workers after selection of candidates for General Nursing course in clause (a) above.
- (c) The Selection Board shall prepare a list for waitlist candidates for General Nursing and Female Health Workers in order of merit after exhaustive exercise of the above clause (a) and (b).
- (d) In the event of the candidates who have been nominated in General Nursing Course surrender the seats, such vacant seats shall be filled up from amongst the candidates who have obtained higher rank/mark in Female Health Worker category; and subsequent result in vacancy in the Female Health Workers category shall be brought from the waitlist candidates in order of merit by adopting pushing up theory.
- (e) The candidates in the waiting list shall be considered by the Selection Board for nomination against the available seats which may arise due to selected candidates surrendering/forfeiting their seats or additional seats which become available to the Government after declaration of the result of the competitive test".

4. Amendment of Rule 6:

In rule 6- Eligibility and Qualification to appear in the Examination, the existing rule shall be substituted by the following:

- (i) the minimum age for admission shall be 17 years and not exceeding 35 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- (ii) the minimum educational requirement shall be 10+2 in Arts (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, and Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Science or Health Care Science-vocational stream

only passing out from an institute recognized by Board/Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur or its equivalent body/council including National Institute of Open School.

- (iii) students shall be medically fit.
- (iv) students shall be admitted once in a year”.

5. **Amendment of Rule 11:**

In Annexure-II to Rule 11-Information for Candidates existing Information No. 2-Eligibility and qualification to appear in the competitive test shall be substituted by the following:

- “(i) the minimum age for admission shall be 17 years and not exceeding 35 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- (ii) the minimum educational requirement shall be 10+2 in Arts (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, and Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Science or Health Care Science-vocational stream only passing out from an institute recognized by Board/Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur or its equivalent body/council including National Institute of Open School.
- (iii) students shall be medically fit.
- (iv) students shall be admitted once in a year”.

6. **Amendment of Rule 15:**

In rule 15, the existing Rule 15-Syllabus for competitive test, the existing provision shall be substituted by the following:

“The written competitive test shall be in English and General Knowledge carrying 50 (fifty) marks each and the standard for written test shall be the same as in the case of Class XII conducted by the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur. The total marks for written test shall be 100 (hundred) in 1 (one) hour duration. Answers shall be multiple choice types and there shall not be any negative marking”.

7. **Amendment of Rule 16:**

In rule 16, the provisions of the earlier Rule 16 of the Rules, 1994 shall be restored in the following:-

“The merit list shall be prepared solely on the basis of marks obtained in the competitive test.

- (a) In the event of one or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the competitive test, their inter-se seniority position shall be determined in the following order:-
- (i) Firstly, the candidates with science background will be placed above the candidates without science subject.
 - (ii) Secondly, the candidates with higher aggregate marks in Class-XII examination (or HSLC examination as the case may be) will be given preference in higher position.
 - (iii) Thirdly, the candidate with earlier date of birth will get preference in the higher position".

8 Amendment of Rule 17:

In rule 17, the existing provisions as per the Third Amendment Rules, 2013 shall be substituted by the following.

"The Selection Board shall prepare Select List and Wait List in order of merit based on the written test separately for Unreserved/General, OBC, ST and SC candidates as per reservation policy of the State Government as per number of seat available".
